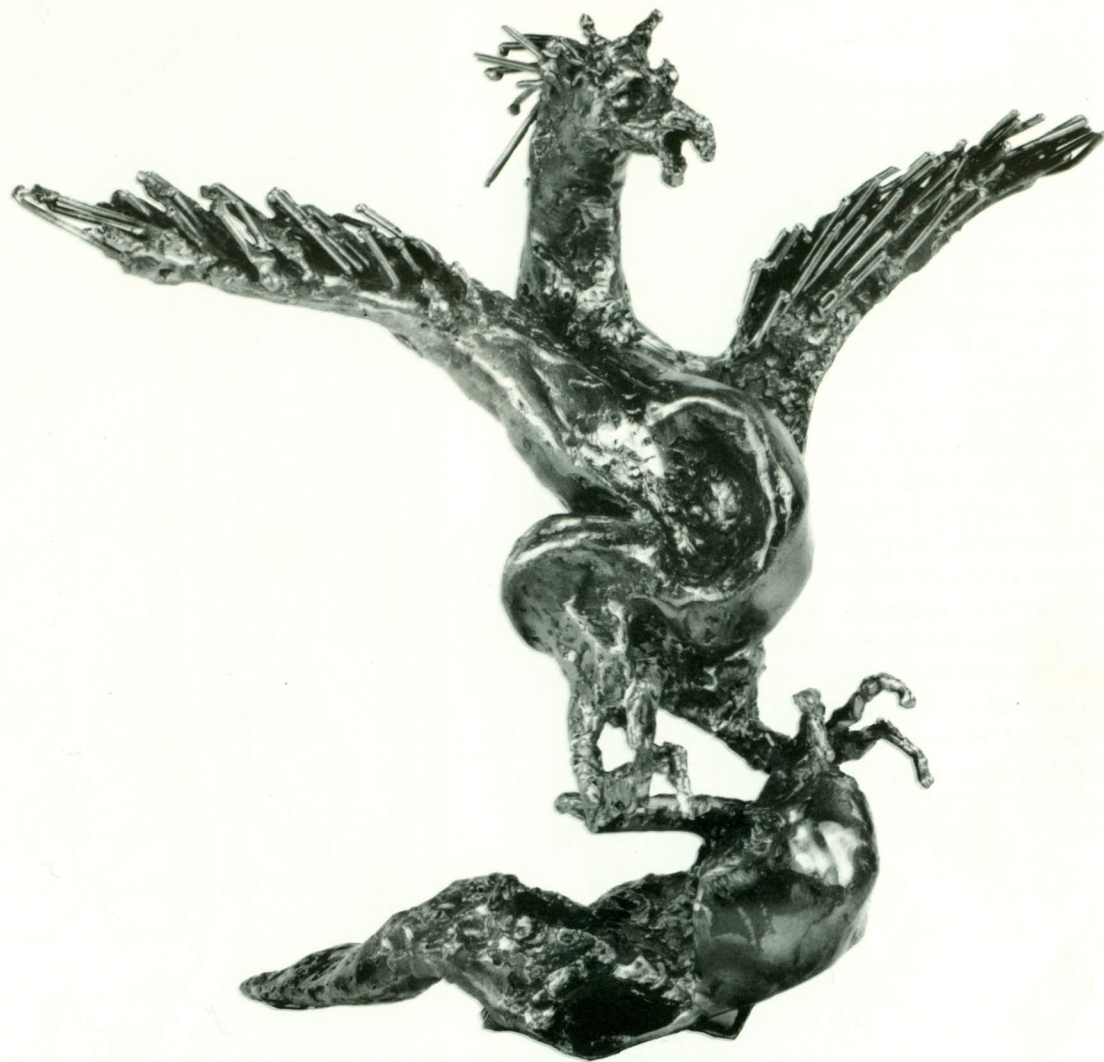


Nannette Clapman Blinchikoff
